

Sen Talk CIC Referral guidelines

An individual or a professional can refer a family to Sen Talk for carer support or child centred support through our intervention programmes.

However, families must meet the criteria below to access the service. Referrals can be made to Annaliese at annaliese@sentalk.org via our electronic referral form or by telephone on **020 7223 1694 Monday - Wednesday 9am-12pm only.**

Sen Talk programmes do not replace statutory services already in place for the family, but deliver specialised SEN programmes aimed at improving family life and individual social and emotional development specifically for SEN children.

Referral criteria:

- Children must have a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder, ADHD or other relevant special educational need (PDA, SPD) or currently under assessment or for any of the above
- Children must be between 4-12 years to access intervention programmes
- Children 7+ (under 16) can attend our Communicate project
- Carers with children of any age can access carer support, events or programmes

We aim for referrals to be responded to within four weeks.
